ACADEMIC RESEARCH ON THE PHILOSOPHICAL LANGUAGE OF BABEL

The Kingdom of Babel is pleased to announce the launch of a formal call for research collaboration with Swiss academic institutions. This initiative forms part of the BABELIRO Project, an interdisciplinary research effort focused on the documentation and analysis of the Babelian Philosophical Language —a formal system of logic and grammar inspired by the interpretation of Genesis 1.

This project is grounded in the hypothesis that the creation narrative in Genesis 1 encodes a logical riddle about the nature of grammatical structure. Through its examination, we seek either to substantiate or refute this claim via rigorous scientific and philosophical inquiry.

Purpose of Collaboration

The BABELIRO Project is seeking to:

- Establish research collaboration with Swiss academic institutions in the preferred fields of:
 - o linguistics,
 - philosophy,
 - o theology,
 - o artificial intelligence,
 - complexity science,
 - o cognitive and behavioural science;
- Offer research opportunities to postgraduate students and early-stage researchers;
- Secure symbolic endorsements (e.g., name recognition, institutional logos) to aid grant viability and public legitimacy.
